## 3 Grades for the Entire Project:

1-100 Written Report

1-100 Oral Presentation ...3-5 minutes maximum

1-100 Visual....informative, creative, neat

**ALL WORK MUST BE STUDENT WORK....**

## Written Report (1-100 points):

- 1 full page minimum
- 2 pages maximum
- 4 paragraphs ...3-5 sentences each
  - 1<sup>st</sup> paragraph....Summarize the book. You MUST include title, author, and genre. Discuss the problem/plot/theme.
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph....Discuss your reaction to the book/characters/message.
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph....Discuss in detail the author's message/purpose for writing the book.
  - 4<sup>th</sup> paragraph....Give your recommendation
    - Would you recommend this book to a friend? Why/Why not?
    - What would you change about the book? Why?
    - What other books, events, or characters does this book remind you of?
    - Other?
- Complete sentences with correct punctuation
- Neat handwriting.....Typed papers must include the handwritten copy.
- Almost no spelling or grammar errors

## Oral Presentation (1-100 points):

3-5 minutes maximum

4 Note cards....1 for each paragraph above.....highlights only....Do not copy your report on the note cards.

Do not read from your note cards.....Use them for quick references to help you remember what you want to talk about.

Also discuss your visual.

### Visual (1-100 points):

- Options
  - Poster (regular poster size or smaller...no tri-fold)
  - Shadow box (shoe box size)
  - Mobile
  - Collage (half poster size)
  - PowerPoint
  - Movie/Drama/etc....must be approved by teacher
- Neat
- Creative
- Unique
- Student created materials...not purchased...when appropriate
