The Elgin School District is located in a rural part of Marion County in Ohio. A large district of nearly 164 square miles, Elgin is comprised mostly of farmland. The Elgin School District serves the villages of Prospect, Green Camp, New Bloomington, and LaRue, and also the western portion of Marion City and surrounding areas. The district serves 1,251 students in grades kindergarten through 12. The district currently has one K-12 building, which was opened in September 2013. This is the first campus-style school building in Marion County.
