

GIMP for IT Tech I & II

1. Select an image, and then **crop** it.
2. **Resize** the image.
3. **Remove the background** from the image.
4. Make the background **transparent**.
5. Select an image that is somewhat blurry. **Reduce the blur**.
6. **Blur** part of the background.
7. **Change the color** of the entire photo.
8. **Change the color** of only a part of the photo.
9. **Change eye color**.
10. **Blend/Combine** two or more images into one image.
11. **Add a watermark**.
12. **Animate** a GIF
13. Change text to **3D**
14. **Use glow effect** on text
15. Make a border with **glowing lines**.
16. **Invert colors** in a title or headline.
17. **Liquefy text** (IWARP)

Show what you know (one class period per items 1-12 below):

1. Make a collage that represents you, containing at least seven (7) images.
2. Make an image of something sliced. What you chose to slice is up to you, but keep in mind it will be easier if you consider colors, textures, etc., that are similar. For example, a frog that is sliced in half with watermelon innards.
